

# Small-scale and intense education



Hotelschool The Hague has been successfully accredited with the distinctive feature of “small-scale and intense education” by the NVAO (The Dutch-Flemish accreditation board) for its Bachelor programme. This means that the Bachelor has been accredited by the NVAO on the following eight criteria:

1. Intended learning outcomes;
2. Relationship between the goal and the content of the programme;
3. Structure and didactic concept;
4. Intake;
5. Quality of staff;
6. Number of staff;
7. Available facilities;
8. Level realised.

This implies for example that the ratio of staff to students at HTH is higher than at most larger institutes of higher education, that the learning goals are more ambitious and that we have a sound selection procedure in place.

Based on this distinctive feature, Hotelschool The Hague is allowed to charge an additional tuition fee.
